

ABOUT WIN

Win is the largest provider of shelter and supportive housing for homeless families in New York City. For more than 35 years, Win has provided safe housing, critical services, and innovative programs to help homeless women and their children rebuild their lives and break the cycle of homelessness.

In the past year, Win served nearly 9,200 homeless people — including more than 5,000 children — and helped more than 700 families transition out of shelter into homes of their own. Most of our families are headed by women, many of whom have fled domestic violence. These are the forgotten faces of homelessness — the mothers, grandmothers, aunts, and sisters who struggle to keep their families together and safe.



It begins with a clean, safe place to live: Win has over 1,700 units of housing

- Last year, nearly 59,000 people slept in New York City shelters every night, including nearly **21,000** children.
- 60% of New York City's homeless are families with children.
- Win houses nearly 10% of the homeless families in New York City.
- In total, Win houses more than 4,700 people each night, including 2,700 children.
- 38% of Win children are under the age of six.
- This year, Win placed over 700 families into permanent housing.

- Win runs 13 family shelters in Manhattan, the Bronx, Brooklyn, and Queens with individual family units.
- 9 out of 10 of our homeless families are led by women.
- Win has over 410 permanent supportive apartment units in Brooklyn, Manhattan, and the Bronx offering continued counseling and other supportive services for mothers/families with special needs.
- Our on-site childcare centers and after-school and recreational programs provide childcare services for homeless children of all ages.

- Win provides 13 weeks of Camp Win, a school break and summer camp for homeless children who reside within Win family residences; Camp Win serves close to 1,000 homeless children a year.
- 44% of Win's work eligible homeless moms are employed.
- In the past year, more than 600 Win clients have achieved employment gains through Win's Income Building Program.
- Win has more than 600 fulland part-time staff members, and a dedicated roster of over 1,000 volunteers.
