



ABOUT WIN

Win is the largest provider of shelter and supportive housing for homeless families in New York City. For more than 39 years, Win has provided safe housing, critical services, and innovative programs to help homeless women and their children rebuild their lives and break the cycle of homelessness.

In the past year, Win served nearly 8,700 homeless people — including more than 4,700 children — and helped more than 730 families transition out of shelter into homes of their own. Most of our families are headed by women, many of whom have fled domestic violence. These are the forgotten faces of homelessness — the mothers, grandmothers, aunts, and sisters who struggle to keep their families together and safe.



It begins with a clean, safe place to live: Win has over 1,700 units of transitional housing.

- Last year, nearly **52,660** people slept in New York City shelters every night, including nearly **17,400** children.
- Nearly **60%** of New York City's homeless are families with children.
- Win provides housing and services for up to **2,100** families every night.
- In total, Win houses more than **4,800** people each night, including **2,700** children.
- **41%** of Win children are under the age of six.
- This year, Win placed over **730** families into permanent housing.
- Win runs **13** family shelters in Manhattan, the Bronx, Brooklyn, and Queens with individual family units.
- **9 out of 10** of our homeless families are led by women.
- Win has over **410** permanent supportive housing apartment units in Brooklyn, Manhattan, and the Bronx offering continued counseling and other supportive services for mothers/families with special needs.
- Our on-site childcare centers and after-school and recreational programs provide childcare services for homeless children of all ages.
- Win provides **13 weeks** of Camp Win, a school break and summer camp for homeless children who reside within Win family residences; more than **600** children attended Camp Win this past year.
- Prior to COVID-19, **53%** of Win's homeless moms were working. Since March 2020, **33%** of Win's work eligible moms are employed and **21%** lost jobs or hours.
- In the last year, Win's Income Building Program served over **2,500** clients.
- Win has more than **600** full- and part-time staff members, and a dedicated roster of over **800** volunteers.
