

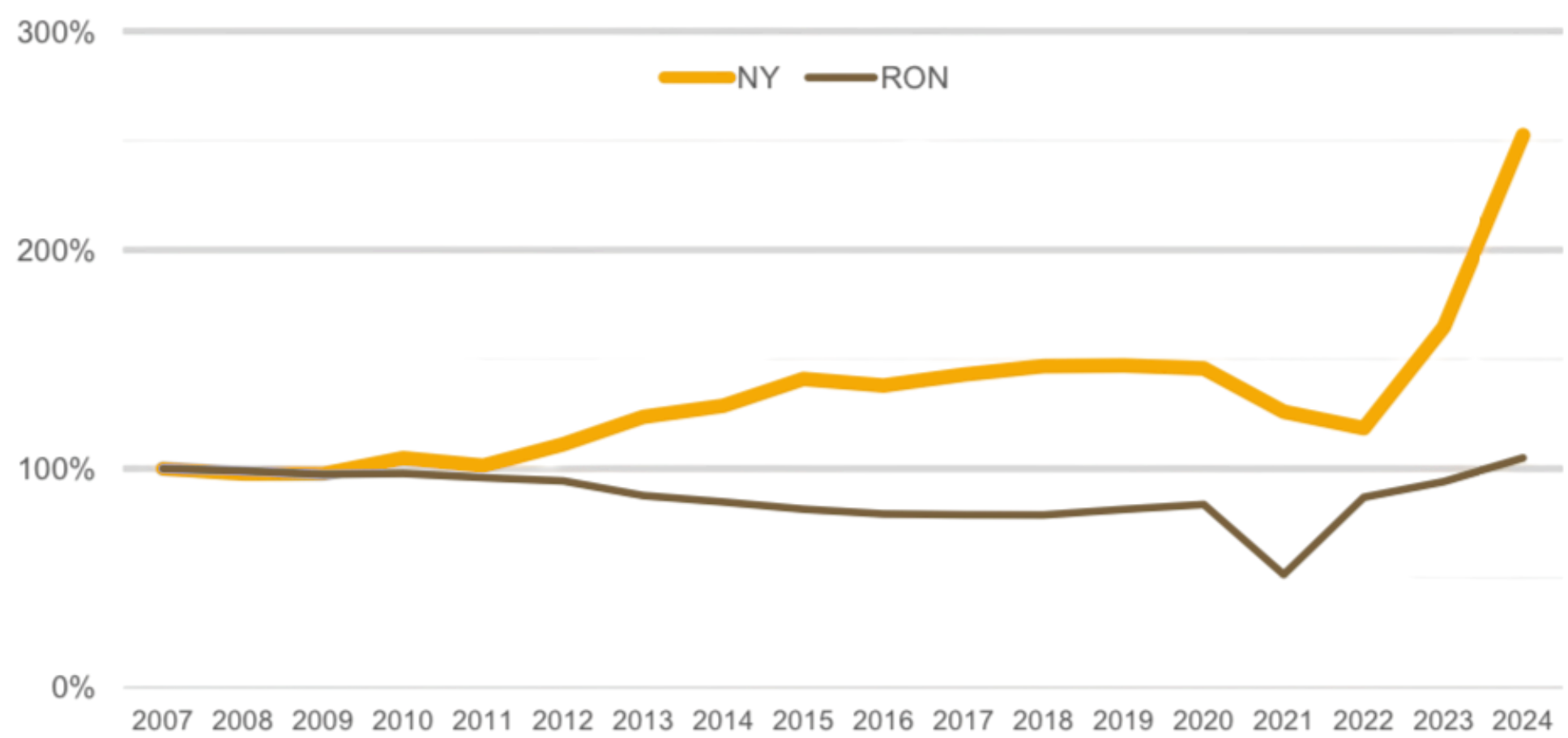
NEW YORK NEEDS HAVP NOW

New York State is in the worst homelessness crisis **in its history**, and it is only getting worse.

158,000

Individuals experienced homelessness last year in New York State (NYS); a record number.

INVESTING \$250M IN HAVP:

- 01 Houses 30,000 New Yorkers who would otherwise be homeless.
- 02 Equates to less than 1% of the proposed budget.

Since 2022, the number of homeless children in NYS has more than doubled from 20,300 to 50,800 kids in 2024.

The Housing Access Voucher Program (HAVP) is the solution.

Preventing homelessness with HAVP could save NY **\$1 billion over 5 years.**

HAVP is a statewide solution that reduces sheltered homelessness regionally by 82% in Western NY, 40% on Long Island, and 47% in the Mid-Hudson Region.

HAVP can be used to move people out of shelter and prevent evictions.

HAVP can prevent catastrophe from EHV Cuts.

HUD announced they will not continue funding 9,501 Emergency Housing Vouchers (EHV's) in NYS beyond this year, nearly 8,000 of which are in NYC.

Without intervention from the State - **thousands of those households** will become homeless.

HAVP is a tool the State can use to prevent this catastrophe.
